Empty Bowls 2003

In the rush to make toys for kids at Christmas, let us not forget our bowl project. Empty Bowls 2002 was a roaring success. It was held at the Meyerson Symphony Center in Dallas under the sponsorship of the North Texas Food Bank. A total of 1050 bowls in glass, ceramics, and wood were donated, the proceeds of which provided 168,000 pounds of food to the Food Bank, which turned it into 210,000 meals. I am told that the wood bowls were a big hit, and went quickly.

For those who don't remember, the \$20 admission gets you a donated bowl. Symbolically, you will get soup in the bowl you select, but in fact the bowls are NOT used to serve soup – you get your soup and dessert in appropriate disposable dishes. All the food is donated by local restaurants, and the entire \$20 goes to the food bank.

This year's event has 2 new features. First, the event will be held simultaneously at the Meyerson in Dallas, benefiting the North Texas Food Bank, and also at the Bass Performance Hall in Fort Worth, benefiting the Tarrant Area Food Bank. Second, there will be a silent auction of the nicer bowls – it was felt that some of the donated bowls should fetch more than the \$20 admission, so these will be selected out to be auctioned.

In the Dallas Area Woodturners, turn in your bowls to Jimmie Arledge. In the Woodturners of North Texas, Larry Genender is collecting bowls. We now have two mouths to feed, so to speak, so look around your shops and let's round up a bunch. Remember, even if you don't think that bowl is worth a hoot, it will bring at least \$20 for a worthy cause. *By Larry Genender*

Library Items Videos and Books


