Meeting Venue

We have now held four monthly meetings at the Riverside Community Center (RCC). The meeting room has been excellent but there are serious problems with parking and the lack of storage and these issues will not improve at RCC. Therefore, we need to see if we can find a better venue for our monthly meetings.

For the foreseeable future we are going to move the meetings to the R.D. Evans Community Center at 3242 Lackland Road in West Ft. Worth. This is the location where we had the Holiday Banquet last year. This will resolve the parking problem because R.D. Evans has a large parking lot. We will be meeting in the room on the South end of the building. This room should also be quieter than the room at Riverside.

This does not resolve the storage issue because R.D. Evans has no space. This may change in the future but we should not count on it. Therefore, I am asking all members to think about locations that are familiar to you that might be suitable. Here is what WNT needs: (1) A meeting room that will accommodate 100 people (about 2000 sq. ft.) with good lighting, (2) Parking for 80 vehicles, (3) Access to a 220v receptacle and four 110v receptacles and (4) Storage for our Powermatic lathe, grinder and A/V equipment. It would be a big plus if the facility also had additional A/V equipment as well as tables and chairs or space for us to store ours.


I am sure that we will be comfortable at R.D. Evans but with the help of the membership we could find a more suitable location.
